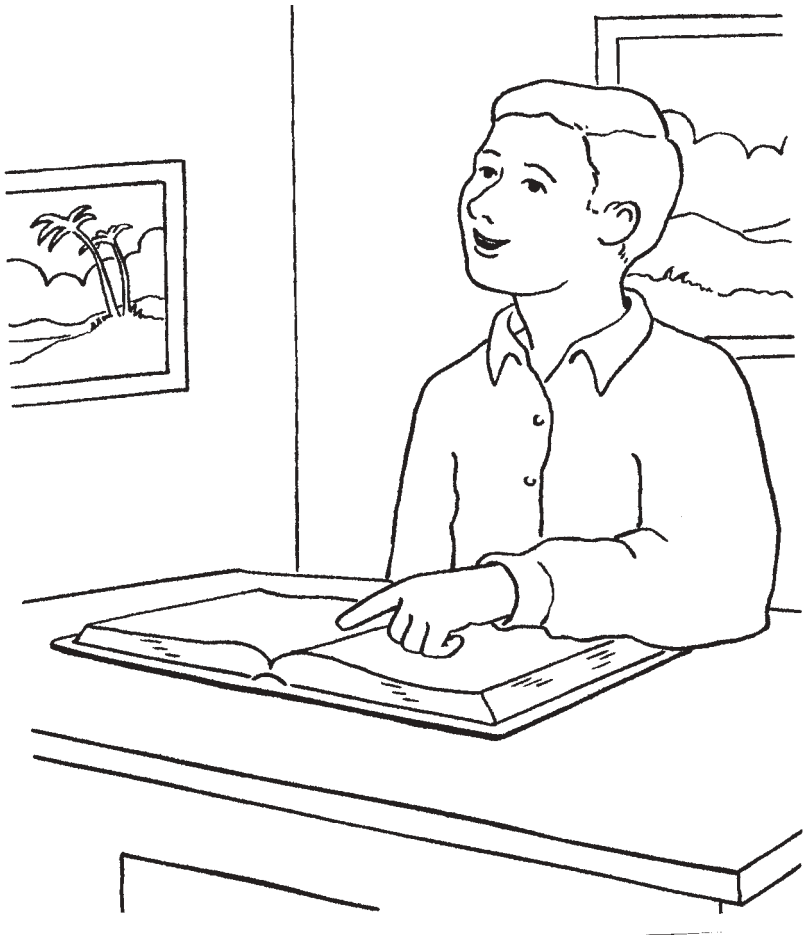

LESSON 4 - The Powerful Word

Memory Verse: **“Is not my word like as a fire? saith the Lord; and like a hammer that breaketh the rock in pieces?”** Jeremiah 23:29

Read Jeremiah 36 about Jeremiah and Baruch and answer these questions:

1. How did Jeremiah feel when the Lord called him to be a prophet? Jeremiah 1:6

2. Who was it who put words in Jeremiah’s mouth? Jeremiah 1:9

3. Where did the Lord tell him to put the words He had spoken to him? Jeremiah 36:2 (Note - these were prepared skins made into a roll.)

4. Who worked as a secretary to write these words down for Jeremiah? V. 4

5. Where did Baruch go, upon Jeremiah's request, to read to all the people of Judah, these words which showed their sin? V. 6

6. This reading of the Book (powerful Word that it is) caused the people to see their need and they fasted before the Lord. During that time, to whom did Baruch again read these words? V. 14

7. What did Jeremiah and Baruch have to do - for safety? V. 19

8. Finally, who heard the words of the Book?
Jeremiah 36:21

9. Did these powerful words which had come from the Lord cause the king to repent and be sorry for his sins?

10. Instead, what did he do with the leaves of the Book?
V. 23

11. How many men tried to stop him from doing this?
V. 25

12. What did the Lord tell Jeremiah to do after the Book
was burned? V. 28

13. What was written in the second Book besides what
was in the first? V. 32

14. What would God have to do to this wicked king who
TRIED to destroy His Word? V. 31

15. Why can man not really do away with God's Word?

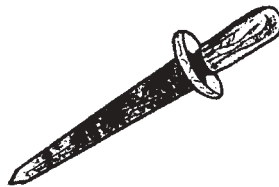
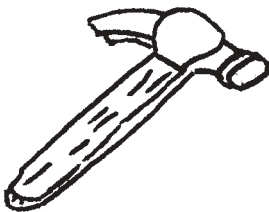

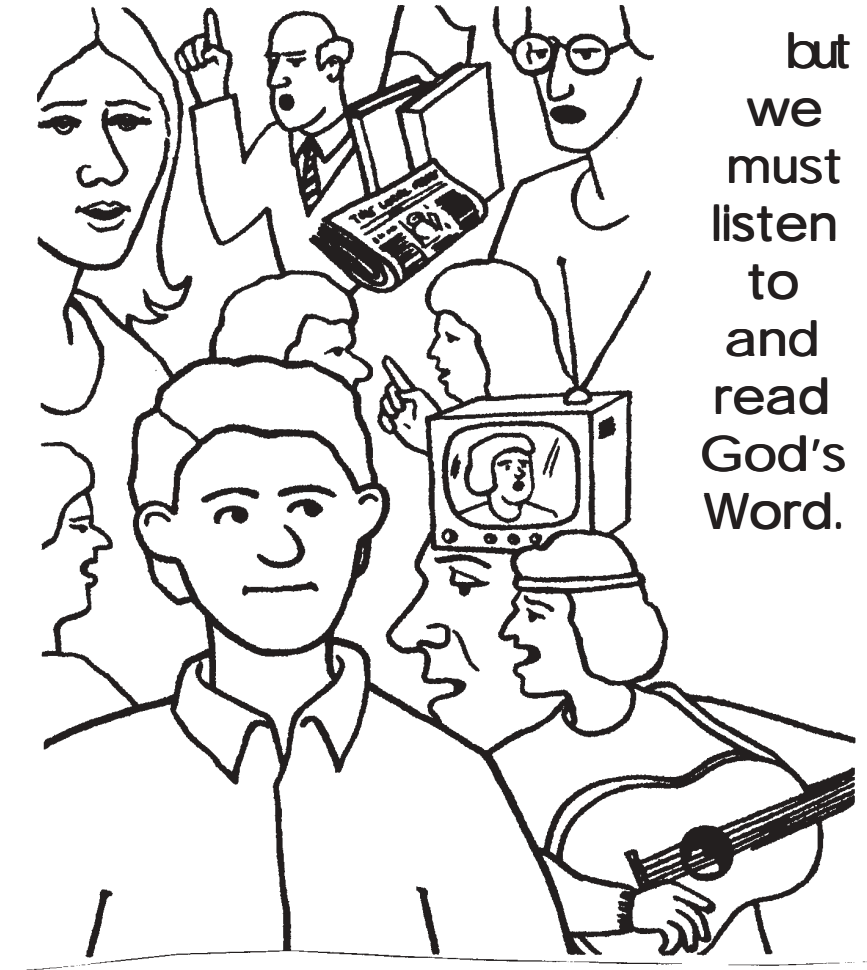
