14. Why must people take this true Bread from Heaven for themselves? John 6:50

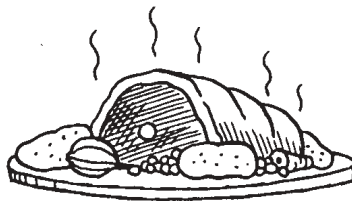
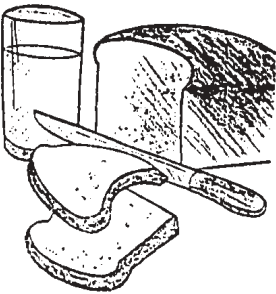

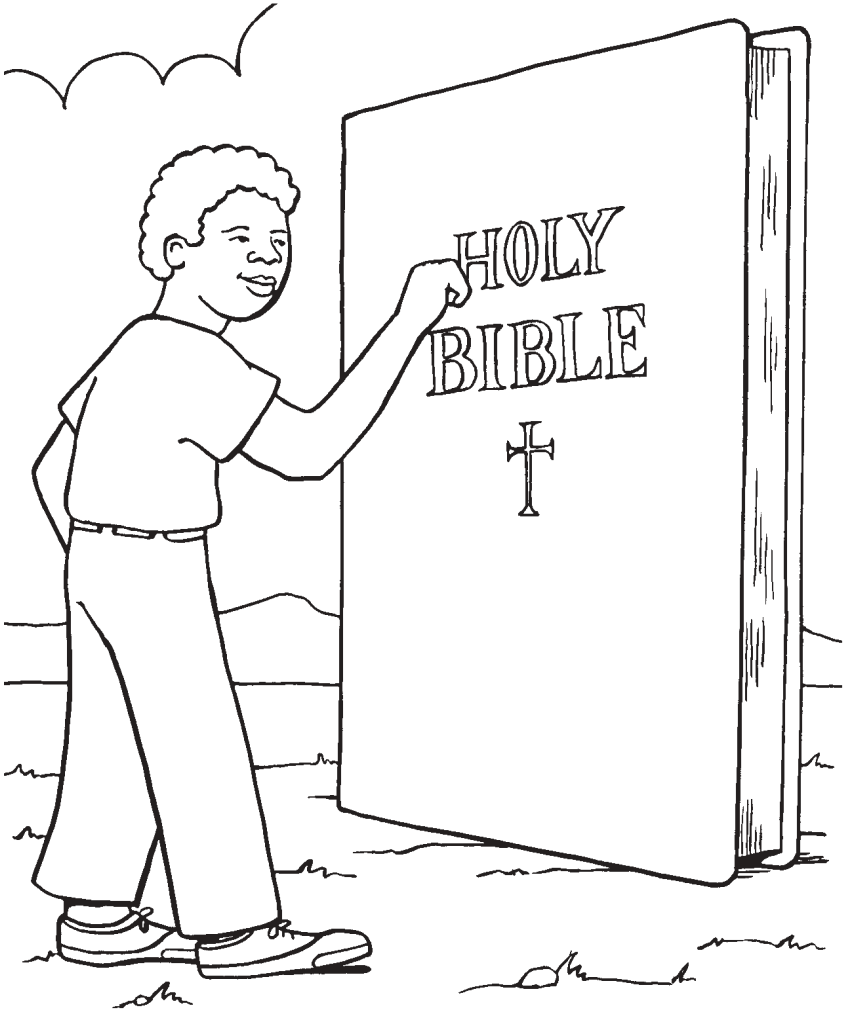
Disappearing Act!
